I would like to take this time to introduce myself as your child's fourth grade teacher. My name is Miss Colandrea, and I am so excited to be a part of your child's learning this school year! This is my fourth-year teaching at Saint Francis of Assisi Catholic Academy. I wanted to share with you a few things to assure we are ready to go for the first day of school.

I hope everyone has been working on their summer work for math and ELA. I attached the Summer Letter again, which includes all of the supplies necessary for this school year. You will see on the Supply List a \$10.00 'Classroom Supply Money'. This is optional but will be very helpful to put towards all supplies I will purchase needed for everyday use for the students.
