## **Regular Full Day School Schedules for All Grades**

**School office:** The school office will be open on Tuesday and Wednesday, August 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. Please call if you have any questions or to make an appointment for registration of new students.

**Tuition Statements:** FACTS Management System will once again manage our tuition invoicing and online payments. Payment plan invitations have been sent via email. Payments are due no later than the 15th of the month for a period of **10 months beginning July and ending in April**. The raffle book for our Mandatory Fall Fundraiser will be sent home upon your return to school. Every family is **required** to purchase/sell one raffle book (\$100.00). All payments can be made via FACTS, or via check or money order through school. Raffle entry stubs should be returned through school as well. Please make sure your Family name, child's name, and grade are noted on all checks and raffle entries.

**Early Drop-Off and Extended Day Programs:** All programs will begin on Monday, September 9th. Early Drop-off begins at 7:15 am. Students should enter through the front door. Staff will not be available before 7:15 am. The cost is \$4.00 per day. The extended day (After school) Program is in session from 2:30-6:00 pm, Monday-Friday unless otherwise noted. The program can be used as necessary. Extended Day Program and Early Drop-off Applications are available in the school office.

<u>Uniforms and shoes:</u> Flynn & O'Hara (flynnohara.com) is our contracted uniform company located in the Atlas Park Mall, 8000 Cooper Avenue, Glendale, (718) 326-2704. Please do not purchase uniforms from any other outlet. The students are required to wear black school uniform shoes and black or white gym sneakers. The shoes should be purchased at DaBar Shoes Too (dabartooshoes.com), 70-05 Grand Avenue, Maspeth, (718) 779-1544, our official shoe store. 3K and Pre-K have the option to purchase school t-shirts, shorts and sweatpants with or without the school name. Please label all items before sending them into school.

**Parent/Student Handbook:** Families will receive a link to the handbook at the Parent Orientation meeting. Please read this handbook with your child/children, sign the tri-fold insert as an agreement to follow all school procedures and policies, and return the tri-fold insert to each child's homeroom teacher.
