You did it! You stepped up from Pre-K and made it to Kindergarten! We promise you that Kindergarten will be a fun yet challenging year. Here are some ideas and lists of supplies that you will need when entering into our class for September.

- 1) Summer Bridge Activities Book (P-K)- please purchase one and have your child complete it throughout the summer. They can be purchased on Amazon! Hold them accountable so that the kindergarten work load will not be such a shock to them come September. We will be collecting them on the first day of school!
- 2) Visit your local library and stock up on some free high-interest books. Ensure that your child reads with you at least 20 minutes each day! Go over initial letter sounds and point out high frequency sight words!
- 3) Have your child write with you for at least 5-10 minutes each day. Tracing letters and practicing to write their names correctly is highly encouraged!
- 4) Practice fast math facts when you're out running errands. It is important for the children to be acquainted with one to one correspondences, at least to 10!
- 5) Have fun! Limit screen time! Run outside and talk about all the beautiful things you see! We can't wait to hear about your summer come September.

We look forward to meeting each of you and working together in two short months! Please review the supply list below so that you can be prepared in September. Please keep supplies simple! Fancy materials tend to be a very big distraction in Kindergarten. ☺

## Kindergarten Supplies:

\*Please bring your pencil case with scissors and colored pencils from Pre-K to class (new students will receive one). The 10 things below are the only supplies you will need to be purchased on your own.

- 1) A backpack (regular sized).
- 2) A lunchbox (no metal).
- 3) Clear contact paper. You will be asked to cover at least 6 textbooks with it.
- 4) 1 folder.
- 5) 2 packs of baby wipes.
- 6) 2 boxes of tissues.
- 7) 1 container of Lysol Disinfecting Wipes.
- 8) 1 can of Lysol Disinfecting Spray.
- 9) 1 individual picture of your child.



In Kindergarten, there is a supply fee and an arts and crafts fee. Your child's other supplies will be purchased through the school using these allocated fees. This is in large part due to the fact that we want each child to have exactly the same thing. Here is a tentative list of some of the Kindergarten supplies that your child will receive.
