Classroom News



Home Extensions

In order to extend learning from school to home try some of these fun together time activities. These activities will reinforce and extend what is being taught in class.

-Provide your child with different scenarios and ask them how they would feel in that specific situation. For example, how would you feel if a classmate knocked down the tower you just built? How would you feel if someone played with you during centers? How would you feel if you received a new toy? Discuss your child's answers. Have them draw a picture of how they would feel.

- Practice writing your child's name with chalk, colorful crayons, or in sand! Remember to practice using one uppercase letter and the rest lowercase.
