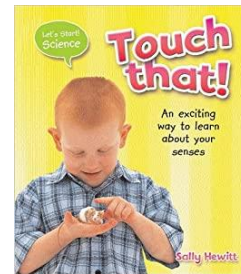
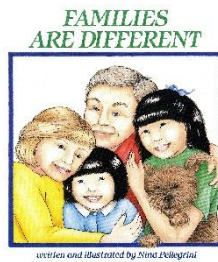
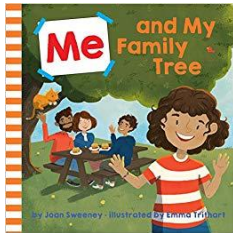
Classroom News
