

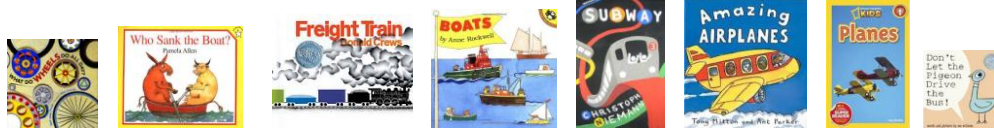
PKFA 110 Newsletter
